

Tex Pattern

Helloooo it's Fearne. By popular demand here is the pattern for Tex <33 love my fellow crocheters. Have fun

Notes:

- ★ All increases & decreases are invisible stitches (invisible increase & invisible decrease)
- ★ I'm using US stitch terms (every sc refers to a UK dc)
- ★ The yarn used was [Cygnet Jelly Baby Chenille Chunky Yarn](#), with a 5mm hook, and 12mm safety eyes.
- ★ I eyeballed connecting the head, arms, legs, and tail. Also inserting the eyes sorry :/. I trust you'll figure out what looks right but I do not have rows to tell you where to attach.
- ★ If there's any confusion on what the pattern is supposed to be doing, dm me on discord @ferb_t and i'll try to get back to you asap.
- ★ If using chenille yarn and it's your first time, a traditional magic ring won't work (You'll tear the yarn and you'll get fluff everywhere, it's a pain to clean up), There's some great vids online with different methods to make one without breaking it, find one that works best for you.
- ★ Everything is worked in rounds — do not sl st between rounds or it'll look clunky, just keep going
- ★ Enjoy your Tex and don't make 50 in the span of 3 weeks or you'll lose all feeling in your fingers

Head


Ch 7 [7]

1. Skip 1 stitch

5sc, 3sc in the last stitch

Work in the back side of the chain

5 sc, 3sc in the last stitch [16]



2. (sc, inc) x8 [24]

3-7. 24 sc [24 for 5 rounds]

8. (5sc, inc) x4 [28]

9. 15sc, 9 inc, 4 sc [37]

10. 16sc, 6inc, 2sc, 6 inc, 7sc [49]

11. 49 sc [49]

12. 16sc, 13dec, 7sc [36]

13. 15sc, 9dec, 3sc [27]

14-15. 27sc [27 for 2 rounds]

16. (3sc, dec)x5, 2sc [22]

17. (2sc, dec)x5, 2sc [17]

Add eyes on approx. row 11 (you should see 2 mounds on the top of the head as eyelids, position the eyes as centrally as you can within these mounds)

Stuff the head (optional – before stuffing, add nostrils and sclera around each eye with black and white yarn)

18. (1sc, dec)x5, 2sc [12]

19. 6dec [6]

Sl st to close and weave the ends shut using front loops of the final 6 stitches. Fasten and weave ends into the head

Stuff body

Sl st to close, weave ends into the front loop of the final 6 stitches to tighten and close. Secure the tail and weave the tail into the body


Attach the head to the top of the body (pointiest/least bulbous part)

Tail

1. 4sc into magic ring [4]
2. (sc, inc)x2 [6]
3. (2sc, inc)x2 [8]
4. 4sc, inc, 3sc [9]
5. 4sc, inc, 4sc [10]
6. 5sc, inc, 4sc [11]
7. 5sc, inc, 5sc [12]
- 8-9. 12sc [12 for 2 rounds]
10. 5sc, 2 inc, 5sc [14]
11. 6sc, 2 inc, 6sc [16]

Sl st to close

Stuff and attach to body



Arms x2

1. 6sc in magic ring [6]
2. (sc, inc)x3 [9]
- 3-4. 9sc [9 for 2 rounds]

Sl st to close

Stuff and attach to body

Legs x2

1. 6sc in magic ring [6]
 2. (sc, inc)x3 [9]
 3. (2sc, inc)x3 [12]
 - 4-5. 12 sc [12 for 2 rounds]
- Sl st to close
- Stuff and attach to body

*Bonus detail, underneath the tail sew a little cross with black yarn to give them a
butthole (true to original plushie)
